

# MEDICAL AND DENTAL HOME

#### What is a Medical and Dental home?

Having a Medical and Dental Home is defined as having insurance, and a primary care doctor and dentist. It is an **ongoing** relationship with the Doctor/Dentist and the patient. Having Well Child Checks every year and Dental exams every 6 months is recommended.

It's important for your child to have regularly scheduled checkups, often called well-child visits, beginning shortly after birth and lasting through the teen years.

These appointments allow your doctor to keep a close eye on your child's general health and development. Finding possible problems early gives your child the best chance for proper and successful treatment. Also, any concerns you have about your child can be discussed during these visits.

During these visits, the doctor examines your child and asks you questions about your child's development and behavior. Immunizations also are either given or scheduled at this time.

Your child's doctor will recommend a schedule for well-child check visits. Example for visits at different ages:

- 3 to 5 days old.
- By 1 month.
- 2 months.
- 4 months.
- 6 months.
- 9 months.
- 1 year.
- 15 months.
- 18 months.
- 2 years.
- 30 months.
- 3 years.

After age 3, well-child visits are usually scheduled yearly through the teen years.

# **Important Steps for Dental Health**

Regular dental exams are an important part of preventive health care.

During a dental exam for children, the dentist or hygienist will clean your child's teeth and evaluate your child's risk of tooth decay. A dental exam for



children might include application of various protective measures — such as sealants or fluoride treatments — to reduce the risk of decay. A dental exam for children might also include dental X-rays (radiographs) or other diagnostic procedures.

During a dental exam for children, the dentist or hygienist will likely discuss your child's diet and oral hygiene habits and demonstrate proper brushing and flossing techniques.

- Children should be taken to the dentist around their 1<sup>st</sup> birthday for their very 1<sup>st</sup> check-up, and every 6 months thereafter!
- If your baby is used to going to bed with a bottle, it's a good idea to help them transition out by adding water instead of milk.
- Baby teeth are important because they help children to speak clearly and to chew their food.
