Did you know?

There are many Certified Passenger Safety Technicians (CPST) employed by Bear River Head Start, local health departments, as well as some hospitals, police, and fire stations. We all want to make sure your child is buckled up appropriately, so you are always welcome to contact any of these places with car seat questions.



ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

- In Utah and Idaho, children are required, by law, to ride rear-facing in the backseat until at least age 1 and weighing at least 20 pounds.
- Children are much safer rear-facing until at least age 2 and weigh over 30 pounds.
- Never, ever leave a child alone in a car.

- All children under 8 years old must ride in a child safety seat or booster, until they are at least 57 inches tall.
- Children should continue to ride in the back seat until age 12.
- Every person in the car, must be buckled up, either in a car seat, booster seat, or with a seat belt.
