Low income families must bring ID and proof of income (WIC or snap card accepted) birth certificates for each child receiving diapers. <p>For other circumstances such as job loss, medical situations, or other emergencies please contact Little Lambs @ 435-764-4439 for more information.</p>	<p><u>Little Lambs Diaper Bank</u></p> <p>The Little Lambs Diaper Bank Assistance Program focuses on providing families access to diapers, wipes, and other basic necessities. We assist with diapers for children up to the age of three. Then we can assist with pull-ups for two months (based on availability). We provide these services through our Little Lambs facility located in Logan, Utah and through our partnering agencies in Logan, Brigham and Ogden, Utah. In addition, we also stock the Department of Child and Family services offices throughout the state of Utah. Every baby deserves to be healthy, happy, and dry. Join us to end diaper need in Utah!</p>
