Early Head Start Pregnancy & Ages 0-3

Early Head Start Program (EHS) offers 2 types of services, *Center Based and Home Based*.

EHS focuses on:

- Child Development
- Parenting/Attachment
- Nutrition and Health
- Literacy
- Employability
- Educational Goals

Center-Based:

Provides quality childcare by teachers trained in early child development. The centers operate with a teacher to child ratio of 1:4. Center based classes offered in Logan, UT are held from Monday-Friday from 8:00am-2:00pm.

Home Based:

Focuses on parents being a child's first teacher. With weekly visits to the home, educators will provide parents and children with Head Start services while also providing social opportunities.

Preschool Head Start Ages 3-5

Preschool Head Start (PHS) offers classroom experiences through our Center Based services.

PHS Center Program Offers:

- Partial Day Classes (4 hours)
- Extended Day Classes (6.5 hours)*
- Class sizes between 14-18 children
- Class days are Monday-Thursday

PHS Focuses on:

- Growing, learning, and developing through an enriched environment
- Allowing child to develop and grow at his/her own rate
- Treating every child as an individual

*Partial and Extended Classrooms are depending on location

**Children must be 3 years old on or by September 1st of the school year they are enrolling into.
