WHICH OPTION IS RIGHT FOR MY FAMILY?

Center Based:

Center based options are a unique learning experience for children 0-3 years old. Each child will have the opportunity to explore and develop in a child lead, structured learning environment.

Mon-Fri 8:00-2:00

Class Size: 8 Children

Teachers Per Class: 2

Home-Based:

This option is founded on the belief that parents are the first and most important teacher of their children. A family Educator will come into the home each week for 1.5 hour visits.

Parents and children are given opportunities to participate in socialization groups.

Pregnant Women:

Receive prenatal education and support in your home, assistance and access to prenatal care, information and assistance in breastfeeding, along with all other program benefits.

WHAT WOULD A SCHOOL DAY LOOK LIKE FOR MY INFANT/TODDLER?

If accepted into a center-based program option, your child would attend our program Monday-Friday 8:00-2:00 PM.

Throughout the day each child is exposed to a variety of hands on learning activities including Free play, outside time, art, sensory and structured group times. Each activity planned is individualized to each child's needs and development.

Three meals are offered to each student while in the center including a breakfast, snack and lunch.

Our educated teachers and staff work one on one with parents and guardians to build routines and set achievable goals for their child.

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS:

Attendance:

Head start has an 80% attendance policy. We believe creating routine for each child is extremely beneficial from a young age.

Each enrolled family in center based is expected to have their child attend each day, but also do our best to accommodate each family and their situation.

Nutrition Accomodations:

Breastfeeding:

Mothers are always welcome to come in to breastfeed their child throughout the day. We also provide formula and are able to properly store breast milk to meet each families needs.

Food Allergies/Restrictions:

Each staff member is aware of each child's food restrictions.

Accomodations are made to make sure all nutrition requirements are met for each child.

Home Visits/Family Conferences:

Each Family is required to participate in two home visits and two family conferences each year. Teachers will meet with parents to set/review goals and talk about the child's progress in the classroom.
